Priest-in-Charge to Rector Discernment On June 4th, the Vestry will be meeting to vote on the topic of calling the Rev. Mary Beth Mills-Curran as our Rector. As you know, we began this process in November when we had a parish meeting to talk about how St. Peter's is doing. We received valuable input from you at that time and met in December to discuss our next steps. After that conversation, we wanted to take some time to reflect on and integrate what we learned from the congregation and set a goal of continuing the process in the Spring.

Our Vestry Retreat in February included professional facilitation in creating a foundation for a strong and vibrant Vestry. It was a good experience for all of us. Since then, we have felt ready to continue the discernment process, understanding that within the Episcopal Church, the decision to call a Rector is made by the Vestry.
